Getting to BASTIA

Airport Bastia Poretta

Bastia Poretta Airport is located in Borgo, 20km from the city center of BASTIA.

Bastia is a small airport there are only direct and daily flights from Paris, Marseille and Nice so you must first reach these cities:

Port Bastia commercial port

Bastia commercial port is located in the city center of BASTIA. You can use the city buses whose station is at the exit of the port (Place Saint Nicolas), take a taxi, or walking to get to your hotel.

Crossings from Italy are from Livorno, Piombino, Genova or Savona. There are three shipping companies available to reach Corsica:

Transport to/from BASTIA airport

There are several ways to get from the airport to Bastia, such as taking a bus that will take you to the city center in about 35 minutes, or take a taxi. Another alternative is to rent a car ...

The shuttle is in front of you when you leave the air terminal and take you to the city center (place Saint Nicolas/prefecture) tickets can be purchased from the driver (only cash) and will cost you 9 euros (you can't buy a return ticket).

You can book your taxi directly on the Corsica-Taxis website. It will cost you about 50 Euros.



Car Hire:

If you want to visit the region, we advise you to rent a car upon your arrival at Bastia airport.

Renting a car category B will cost you between 50 and 70 Euros.

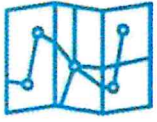

To do in BASTIA

Enjoy your stay, visit the city!

The historic sites of the city constitute the tourist heart of Bastia. The citadel surrounded by its ramparts, dominates the Old Port. We discover the Palace of the Governors (where the Genoese governors lived), which today houses the Museum of Bastia. Below, the Old Port, concentrating many restaurants and bars. The rue Napoleon (pedestrian), the market (Saturday and Sunday morning), then the place Saint-Nicolas, one of the largest in France.

Beach lovers will enjoy the Marana, south of the city and the nature reserve of the Biguglia pond, where around 240 species of birds nest.

Those who stay longer and rent a car will be able to visit the area: Cap Corse, north of Bastia, with its little villages on the mountainside, Saint-Florent, Calvi, Corte...

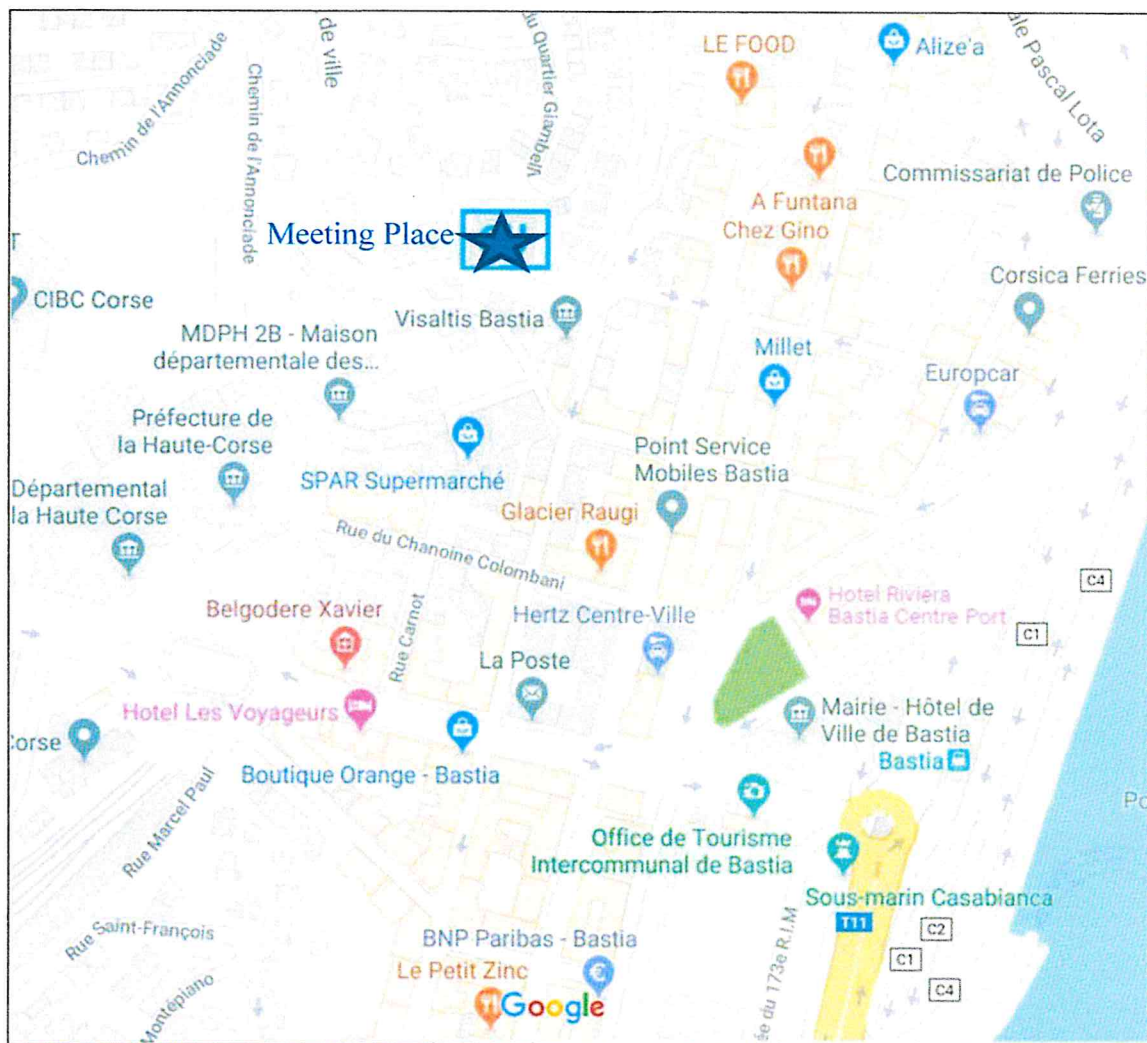
